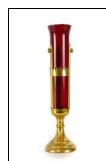

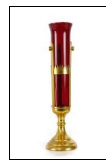

Diocesan Missions Sunday

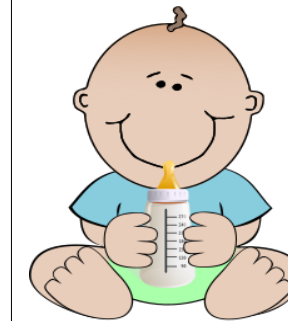

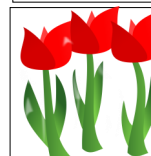

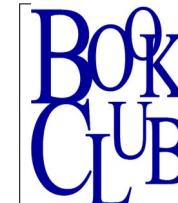
