Liturgical Ministry Information

Altar Server- Being an altar server is a great way to learn more about our Church, get an up-close and personal experience of Mass, and perform an important service for your parish family. Altar servers play an important role in the opening and closing processions, and assist the priest during the celebration of Mass. New servers are paired with an experienced server for their first few Masses.

Cantor- Are you looking for a way to participate more fully in Mass and use your musical talents to enhance the liturgy and inspire others to lift their voices in song? If you were blessed with a beautiful singing voice please consider leading our congregation in prayerful song.

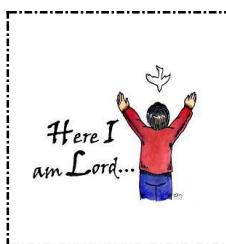
Communion Minister- Holy Communion is the most central and important of all the sacraments. Communion ministers assist Father and Deacon in distributing the Body and Blood of Christ.

Commentator/Lector - Do you enjoy welcoming all to Mass and inviting people to greet those nearby? **Commentators** announce the beginning of Mass and lead the Prayers of the Faithful (if a Deacon is not present). Would you like to help others hear clearly the Word of God at Mass? **Lectors** joyfully proclaim God's Word to the congregation. Lectors prepare at home by practicing the chosen Readings for Sunday.

Sacristan- Get a behind-the-scenes look into what goes into preparing for Mass. The Sacristan's role is to prepare the sacred worship space where the liturgies are celebrated. The Sacristan arrives 20 minutes prior to the start of Mass.

Usher- Ushers welcome all who enter church and assist in seating. They provide the first impression of what a Parish might be like. Ushers check the Commentator sheet to be sure those who are scheduled to serve are present, ask someone to bring up the gifts, take up the collection, and handle the collection after Mass.

Please prayerfully consider sharing your time and talent in one or more Liturgical Ministry. If you are willing to serve, please fill out the bottom portion of this paper, detach, and put into the designated basket at the back of church.
