

The Lord is Risen Indeed!

I cannot say how moving it was to see so many of you at Mass on Easter Sunday! It was a special blessing to see so many folks whom we had not seen since the pandemic, worshipping and receiving the Lord in Holy Communion. It has been such a trial to see so many empty places in Church. Welcome back and may God bless you richly in this Easter Season.

Bishop Matano expressed his concerns in a letter he recently sent to the priests and deacons of the diocese. He, as the chief teacher of the diocese, tells us, "We all face the serious task of welcoming back parishioners to the regular worship of God at Mass and to parish life.... and we must help our people understand the need for personal encounter with the Eucharistic Christ physically present at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass." The Bishop then gives us a challenge — a strong, emphatic challenge, as he says, "Parishes must now begin programs of catechesis and evangelization to welcome back our people through parish communications, parish bulletins, newsletters, telephone calls and being present to the sick and dying; the days of Lent, Holy Week, the Sacred Triduum and Easter are such opportunities."

"Parishes must now begin...". Pretty strong words, so what do we do and when do we do it? We've got a plan and we're ready to start. As you may know, Pope Francis has declared this year the Year of Saint Joseph. Well, do you remember when we would have Parish Missions? Get ready because we are going to have a series of

mission-like talks throughout the Eastern Wayne County cluster focused on Saint Joseph. The priests and Mr. Carlo Stebbings, and I will be giving these on a rotating basis and we urge everyone to come and to participate. (Please see



the schedule above.) Now, you might ask

how a parish mission focused on Saint Joseph is a way of inviting us back to Mass and to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. It's because Saint Joseph always pointed away from himself and towards Jesus who is The Way, the Truth and the Life and the only way to the Father. Saint Joseph's example of devotion, obedience, prayerful listening, and self-denial provides a perfect pattern for our lives as we strive to follow Christ.

Come and listen, come and pray, come and worship! Christ is Risen! He is Risen Indeed!
