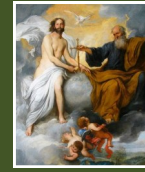

a pregnancy and beyond. Our mission is to offer Christ-centered compassion, hope, and help to women and men facing unexpected pregnancy and making life-changing decisions.

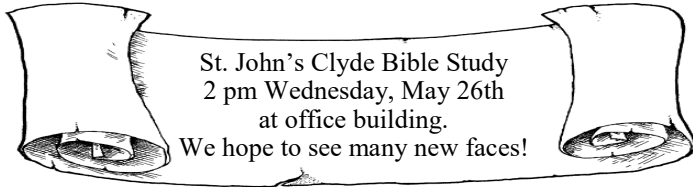

CCBT Parish Pastoral Council Nominations

Those nominated must be fully initiated Roman Catholics in good standing with the Church, be registered and supporting members of the parish, be participants in parish life and worship and be committed to prayer, study, listening and dialogue, as well as be committed to giving the time needed for participation.

Some of the gifts Council members should possess are a desire for spiritual growth in oneself and in the parish, eagerness to participate in parish decisions about its direction, and a willingness to listen, speak openly and honestly, and to work toward consensus.
