Today, we celebrate mothers everywhere. The one's who gave birth to us, the ones who raised us, the ones who have been there to celebrate our achievements, and have been there to absorb the tears of our failures. My hope is that everyone gets a chance today to give your mother a hug, or at least a phone call, to remind her of just how special and important she is to you

I always found it very fitting that Mother's Day falls in the month of May. As we do so, may we also never forget our spiritual mother, who sits with her Son in the Heavenly kingdom, always willing to help us and guide us along this earthy journey.


