## 2020/2021 Catholic Ministries Appeal

- We surpassed our goal at $101.38 \%$ ! As of June 8, there were 82 donors for a total amount of $\$ 16,431$. This was $\$ 224$ over our target goal. Half of this (\$112) is given back to our Parish. The target goal for next year has been reduced by DOR.
- Fr. Felicjan will make an announcement about meeting our goal at Masses this week.
- Kathy and Paul will write an article for the June 20 bulletin.
- Process improvements discussed for next year
- Show the video at the beginning of the campaign as has been done in past years and revisit the campaign in January/February.
- Have the priests speak about CMA.
- Continue to publish bulletin articles/appeals as the campaign progresses.
- Possibly set challenges to meet certain goals on the thermometer as the campaign progresses.

## CCBT Parish Pastoral Council Nominations

- Fr. Mike asked about officer nominations. It was decided to table officer nominations until September.


## "A Pastoral Guide to Opening Your Parish"

- Current Parish Directory of Active Parishioners and Current/Updated List for CMA
- Marie met a second time with Mary D. and the focus was updating the Family List based on over 30 CMA letters being returned to the office as undeliverable.
- Kathy and Mary K. plan to meet with Mary D. the week of June 14 to continue identifying parishioners who are active, inactive, deceased or have moved and make the changes in Parish Soft. They will begin with last names beginning with K.
- Kathy will contact Colleen Brade (Associate Director, Coordinator of the Annual Catholic Ministries Appeal) to remove deceased parishioners from the CMA list.
- Colleen recommended sending a survey to update the census.
- Communication and Where People Are Right Now/Pastoral/Ministries
- The need for a CCBT secretary and a replacement for Lisette (Pastoral Minister) at SJW continues. The positions have been posted but no one has answered the call. In the meantime, Mary D. will continue to assist in the office. Contact the office with any needs that arise.
- Faith Formation continues to be in the planning stages. One of the challenges is how to meet the needs of all children in the cluster. Father Mike will talk to Maureen Mahoney to see if she is still the lead person at CCBT or if she is stepping down.
- Diane Poole is waiting for the information to provide specific guidelines to those who serve as Liturgical Ministers regarding CASE training, as was discussed at the meeting on May 18th. In addition, she needs to know which ministries need to be scheduled. Currently the schedule includes Altar Server, Musician, Cantor, Commentator/Lector, Coffee Hour, Communion Ministers, Musicians, Sacristan, and Ushers. Father Mike reported Mary D. and Mary C, are working on this, the goal being to have new people trained by the end of June.

- Missalettes are not yet permitted so it is difficult to sing hymns without the words. Mary K. offered to make copies of the hymns to be sung at Mass, but it is not cost effective and requires a lot of coordination with the Musicians. We will discuss this further in September.
