

On June 6th, September 5th and December 5th, these devotions will be held with Confessions and with the singing of the Divine Mercy Chaplet. As in other months, the service will begin at 2 pm with Chaplet at 3 pm. Benediction ends the services.

On the First Fridays of every month, immediately following the 8:30 am Mass at St. Michael's Church, Lyons, there is Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament followed by Benediction at 10 am.

Priesthood

Last Saturday, June 5, two men were ordained to the priesthood at Sacred Heart Cathedral in Rochester: Fr. Joseph Maurici and Fr. Steven Lewis are now the two newest members of the presbyterate for the Diocese of Rochester. I was unfortunately unable to attend, as I had a funeral and wedding that same day, but it did give me cause for reflection.

Every year at this time, whether I am able to attend the ordinations or not, I can't help but think back to my own ordination. On June 3, I celebrated my fourth anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood. In many ways, I cannot believe it has already been four years since that day. But honestly, I still cannot imagine myself doing anything else with my life. Not a day has gone by since my ordination where I haven't been grateful for the opportunity to serve as a priest.

I'm sure that just about all of us have heard at some point someone say "if you love what you do, you never work a day in your life." While this is a very clichéd statement, there really is a lot of truth in it. Even though there are many challenges in pastoral ministry, the joys far outweigh the struggles. To be able to serve as a priest in Christ's Church has been an unbelievable honor and privilege over the past four years, and I can honestly say, as I have said many times, that I cannot imagine doing anything else with my life.

We all know, of course, that there is currently a major shortage of priests in our diocese. More than half of our priests are over than 60 years old, and many of them have either reached senior status or are nearing senior status. This is the reason why so many of our parishes are having to cluster together and merge, and why so many churches have closed in recent years. The Church is in need of more vocations to the priesthood and vowed religious life. We know, of course, that without priests, we have no access to the sacraments.

Now, perhaps more than ever before, we need to pray for and foster vocations throughout the diocese and the world. I ask you to continue to pray for vocations, particularly for the Diocese of Rochester. And if you know of anyone who might be thinking of priesthood, don't hesitate to encourage them. But above all, we must continue to trust in our Good Shepherd, who promised that he would never leave us as orphans, and who never ceases to call those he has prepared to pasture his flock.
