



"I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." Mt 6.35

The crowd did not seek Jesus for His great signs and wonders which they had seen, but because they had eaten for free, without effort and work. But those who ate should have been concerned not about the mundane food which perishes, but for the food which endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man would give them. They did not understand Him. They thought it was a magic food, which would satisfy them for a long time and would not have to be consumed daily. Therefore, they cried, "Lord, give us this bread always." But Jesus answered them: "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry; and he who believes in me will never thirst."

Many were scandalized by His words and went away. They did not believe Him. And after a time, He fulfilled His promise. On the eve of His Passion, at the Last Supper, He instituted the Eucharist and commanded the Apostles and their successors to do the same thing, and they believed in Jesus and fulfilled the command.

And we? Do we really believe that He is here with us in the Blessed Sacrament? Do you remember when you go to church? He is truly alive and present but hidden under the appearance of bread. So, strive to remember this when you go to the house of God. Then kneel down if you can and confess faith in the presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, saying: "Praised be the Blessed Sacrament, now and ever and always. Amen."

And then tell the Lord Jesus that you believe in His presence here and that you love him more than anything and regret your weaknesses and sins.

Let us be faithful to the Sunday Eucharist. With great faith and respect, let us take part in it and never let us to neglect so great a Savior.
