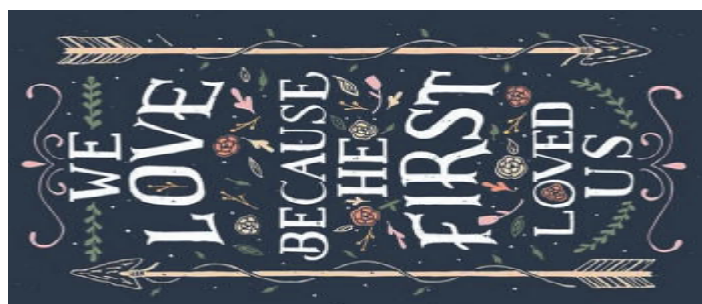

A Message From Fr. Felician

As you may know, I am going to Poland to visit my family (my father, two sisters, two brothers, twelve nieces and nephews). My mother passed away three years ago.

This year I have the opportunity to be with my family on November 1st for a remembrance at our cemetery. So I would like to write you a few words about our Polish custom on All Saints Day.

In Poland there are thousands of people around the cemetery and the streets are blocked off. Police are everywhere stopping cars from coming in but this is not like a major sporting event or a big-ticket concert happening in Cracow. This is the first of November, All Saints Day. One of the most important and magical days in the Polish nation.

On this day people go to the cemeteries where their loved ones, former family members and friends are buried. They go because they want to pay their respects. They clean the graves and leave behind extraordinary votive candles, reeds, and flowers in order to remember people that were close to them. It's a beautiful day!

The cemetery is filled with life and color. Then as the evening descends, all present witness the extraordinary sight of a sea of candles in the darkness and so many Poles coming together to celebrate their culture, tradition, and the people that they love.
