

A Further Reflection from Fr. Felicjan

All Saints Day in Poland is the day that families come together; frequently meeting for the first time in months. They go to the graves of the important people in their family to remember them. This is true not only for the older folks but for the children as well. The Poles are keeping together this tradition as families and as a nation by carrying out this simple but powerful act.

The origins of All Saints Day lies in a mix of Slavic and Catholic traditions but it is part of the official Catholic calendar celebrated throughout Europe. Still, nobody does it quite like the Poles! Cemeteries come

alive with rippling layers of light. Flying over Poland on this day and in the days ahead you see cemeteries which have literally sprung to life with light. If someone finds a grave close to their loved one that hasn't been visited or



cleaned and with no candle, they'll place a candle there out of kindness.

Polish cemeteries are filled with the great people who have gone through immense sacrifices for Poland's freedom. This is especially true in this part of the province where a key military cemetery pays tribute to the soldiers who were killed and whose bodies were suspected of being dumped somewhere in this cemetery but have never been found by the Communist authorities. In particular, a Captain Vitold Poleski was most famous for volunteering to go into Auschwitz and set up the underground resistance there before escaping the fighting in the Warsaw uprising. He was eventually captured and executed by the Communist authorities.



Why is All Saints Day so important in Polish history and culture? What does it mean for us today? I think it's mainly due to the fact that Poland is a very religious nation by nature and this is the day that we remember and commemorate our loved ones and

fallen heroes. This is truly ground zero as far as Polish martyrdom is concerned.

Is it important to you that your children accompany you as you go to the graves of your family members and loved ones as well? This is a good opportunity to tell them stories which make them aware of our history and sacrifice that this nation had to bear to achieve its freedom.
