



#### 1st Friday Exposition at St. Michael's in Lyons

On the First Fridays of every month, immediately following the 8:30 am Mass there is Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament followed by Benediction at 10 am.

At **St. John the Evangelist church in Clyde,** on every 1st Sunday of each month, Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament are held, with the *recitation* of the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Benediction ends the services. Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament begins at 2 pm. The Divine Mercy Chaplet is *recited* at 3 pm, followed by Benediction.

On December 5th, these devotions will be held with Confessions and with the *singing* of the Divine Mercy Chaplet. As in other months, the service will begin at 2 pm with Chaplet at 3 pm. Benediction ends the services.


