

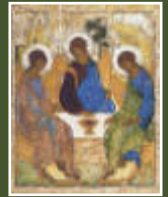

1st Friday Exposition at St. Michael's in Lyons

On the First Fridays of every month, immediately following the 8:30 am Mass there is Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament followed by Benediction at 10 am.

At **St. John the Evangelist** church in Clyde, on every 1st Sunday of each month, Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament are held, with the **recitation** of the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Benediction ends the services.

Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament begins at 2 pm. The Divine Mercy Chaplet is **recited** at 3 pm, followed by Benediction.

On December 5th, these devotions will be held **with Confessions and with the singing of the Divine Mercy Chaplet**. As in other months, the service will begin at 2 pm with Chaplet at 3 pm. Benediction ends the services.

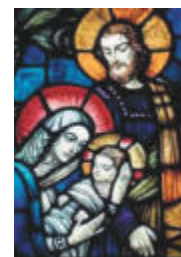
Mission Statement

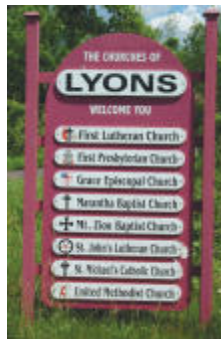
