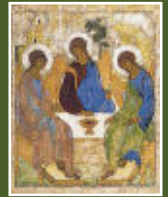

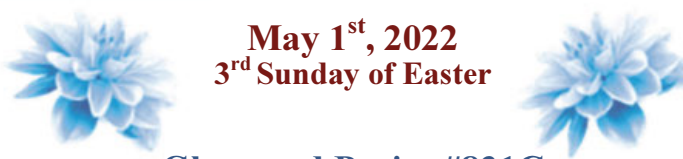

#### Living in Grace through the Sacraments

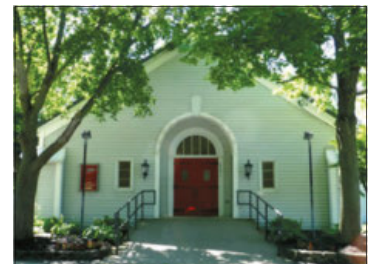
