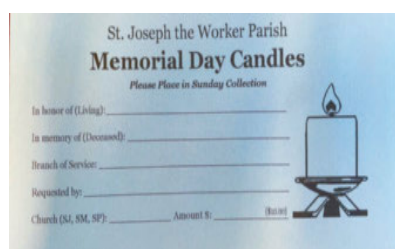
Diocesan Missions Sunday

Mother's Day

Today, we celebrate mothers everywhere. The one's who gave birth to us, the ones who raised us, the ones who have been there to celebrate our achievements, and have been there to absorb the tears of our failures. My hope is that everyone gets a chance today to give your mother a hug, or at least a phone call, to remind her of just how special and important she is to you.

I always found it very fitting that Mother's Day falls in the month of May. After all, May is the month dedicated to Mary, and Mary, though a virgin, is both the Mother of God as well as the mother of us all. When Jesus was on the cross, he spoke to both his mother and the beloved disciple John: "Woman, behold your son", and "behold, your mother".
