

pers in sizes 5 and 6. No matter which church you attend in the cluster, if you would like to help fulfill this need it would be greatly appreciated. The diapers can be placed in the Family Promise bin located at the back of each church. The collection will run through the month of June. If you are wondering about the impact of Family Promise of Wayne County here are some interesting statistics: 2,252+ meals have been served since 2018, 95% of families graduate into stable housing, 52 days is the average stay in the program, and there are about 350 volunteers in Wayne County. Parking passes for the picnic will be available both at St. Jude in Fair Haven and at St. Mary Magdalene in Wolcott.


Backpack Collection
