

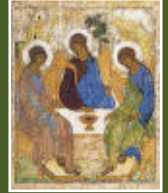

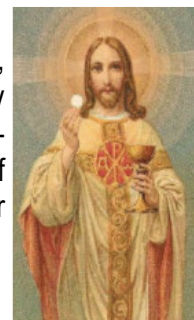

K-7th! (Ages 4-13)

On July 4th, we celebrate this country's Independence Day. It is a 3-day weekend filled with family barbecues, hot dogs, apple pie, picnics and outdoor activities. There are patriotic parades, flags flying and fireworks. This day represents the birth of the United States of America as an independent nation. Americans are a freedom loving people who value their independence as individuals as well as for the country. Liberty, freedom and justice are the cornerstones of our democracy. They were spelled out in the Declaration of Independence. We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness. In the midst of all the celebrations it is important to reflect on one of the words in that statement. That word is "endowed". It means gifted. All of these rights that we refer to have been gifted to us. The statement continues identifying the source of these gifts, "by their Creator". Therefore along with celebrating independence as a nation there should also be recognition of where this independence comes from. Our Independence is rooted in our Dependence on God. All that we have comes from God. Every Sunday our liturgies emphasize this dependence on God. In the Liturgy of the Word we are reminded of how God worked in the lives of the Israelites and how much they depended on Him. The Psalm tells us "The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want". We depend on God for our salvation. The Gospel of Matthew tells us to "not be anxious about your life, what you shall eat or what you shall drink, nor about your body, what you shall put on... Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them." In the Prayers of the Faithful we present our needs and petitions to God knowing how dependent we are on Him. In the Lord's Prayer we are reminded that God is our provider when we pray: "Give us this day our daily bread." The word Eucharist means thanksgiving. Each Sunday when we participate in the celebration of Mass, we acknowledge our dependence on God and give Him thanks for all our blessings. One day a year we celebrate our country's independence. Each Sunday we celebrate our dependence on God. Each Sunday is Dependence Day. Have a happy and safe Fourth of July weekend and remember to always pray for our military personnel, past and present.
