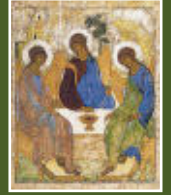

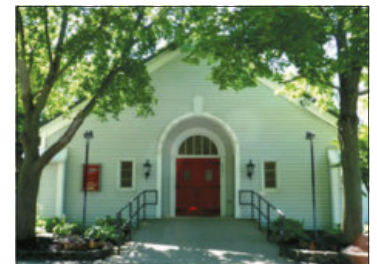

If you are wondering about the impact of Family Promise of Wayne County here are some interesting statistics: 2,252+ meals have been served since 2018, 95% of families graduate into stable housing, 52 days is the average stay in the program, and there are about 350 volunteers in Wayne County.
