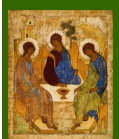

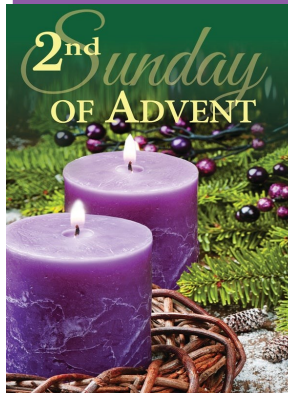

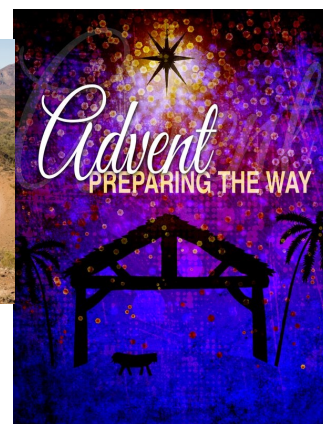
Dear Parishioners,  
Remember, December 8th is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. It is a Holy Day of Obligation.

**Can we make this Advent 2022 different this year?**

We all must commit to making some room for Christ and commit ourselves to the project of making this Advent time, a time of spiritual refreshment and renewal in our lives. *What can*
