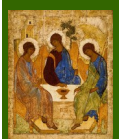

Building Strong Catholic Families

Pentecost is sometimes called the birthday of the Church. The Gospel for Pentecost reminds us that the Church begins with the command to forgive. Within the family, the domestic Church, we learn how to forgive and how to accept forgiveness. The gift of the Holy Spirit enables us to do both. Today is a fitting time to share a family celebration of reconciliation. As a family, sit quietly for a few minutes, inviting everyone to reflect upon their need to forgive and to receive forgiveness. If there is a situation or an issue within the family that needs attention, spend some time reflecting on how your family might address it. Pray together today's Psalm or the Prayer to the Holy Spirit, asking that the Holy Spirit help your family. Share with one another a Sign of Peace.

The Resurrection of the Body

When Christ comes again in glory on the last day, all who have died will get their bodies back.

For those who have chosen Heaven, this means we will be able to delight in God and praise Him with our bodies as well as our souls. It means we will experience the joy of Heaven with our full humanity, as God originally intended.

How can we imagine this final fulfillment of all God's designs? Here, it's probably best to let Scripture have the last word. Read Revelation 21:1-5!

How incredible does that sound? Is that not worth waiting for? Is that not worth working towards? Every time we say "Thy Kingdom Come," what an astonishingly beautiful end of the story we're looking forward to. Let's ask God for the grace to prepare ourselves for that fearful, glorious day.

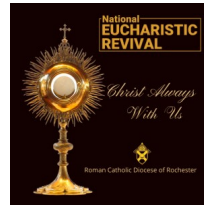

EMBER DAYS are the days of prayer and fasting that mark the changing of times and seasons in order to bring about deeper spiritual renewal.
